

## **Pre-Requisites:**

This is just a reminder about the rules regarding pre-requisites for economics courses. Below are the pre-requisites for all of the undergraduate courses. Hence, the list below tells you what to expect your students to already know.

Please note that if a student asks you to take your course without completing the mandated prerequisites then that approval does not guarantee that the student will receive credit for the course from the department.

- The only way for the student to get a waiver for a prerequisite is to speak to his or her advisor in the department.
- If the advisor approves that waiver, it will be placed on file in the department so that when the student goes to graduate we will have all of the necessary paperwork.

To reiterate the information stated above, when a student asks to take your course without the prerequisites, please send that student to see his or her advisor - do not grant them permission to take the course yourself.
