SHINE - The Social and Health Impact of Network Effects Info Sheet

What is the objective of this study?

- To better understand the connection between social networks and health behavior

What does the study involve?

- Online surveys
 - Basic questions about yourself, personality, and health behaviors
 - Questions about your participation in on-campus social groups and your relationships with others in those groups
- fMRI scan (optional if eligible)
 - Following the online survey, some people will be invited to participate in an fMRI scan session

What is the time commitment?

- Initial online survey: 60-75 minutes
- Two follow-up online surveys: 60 minutes each
 - First follow-up survey is six months after initial survey
 - Second follow-up survey will take place at the end of the study

How do I benefit from this?

- Earn up to \$80 for completion of online surveys
 - Initial online survey: \$20 Amazon gift card and \$20 bonus gift card to Amazon, &Pizza, or Chipotle restaurant if 80% of your group completes the survey
 - Two follow-up online surveys: \$20 Amazon gift card for each

- Participants will not have access to anyone else's survey responses.
