Fact-checkers: Washington Post, PolitiFact, FactCheck.org, New York Times,


However, fact-checkers cannot keep up with the explosive spread of misinformation


- Human fact-checkers spend between 4 hours and 1 day to check one claim (Duke Reporters' Lab)
- 800 million tweets (30% retweets) posted per day, each potentially with false information





Presidential Debate Transcripts

- All 33 presidential debates from 12 general elections in history: 1960, 1976—2016.
- 23,533 sentences by presidential candidates after removing 2,789 very short (< 5 words) sentences.

Important Factual Claims

Classification and Ranking by Check-worthiness DiR

CFS: Important factual claims

"We spend less on the military today than at any time in our history."

"The President's position on gay marriage has changed."

"More people are unemployed today than four years ago."

UFS: Unimportant factual claims

"I was in Iowa yesterday."

"My mother enjoys cooking."

"I ran for President once before."

NFS: No factual claims (opinions, questions & declarations)

"Iran must not get nuclear weapons." "7% unemployment is too high." "My opponent is wishy-washy." "I will be tough on crime." "Why should we do that?" "Hello, New Hampshire!" "Our plan is to reduce tax rate by 10%."






