



2018 NEW JERSEY HISTORY AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION CONFERENCE

Call for Posters

New professionals, undergraduates, and graduate students are invited to submit proposals for the 3rd annual Poster Session of the New Jersey History & Historic Preservation Conference.

Submission deadline has been extended to: April 30, 2018

The Poster Session is an opportunity to present your historical research. Posters must engage subjects or projects related to historic preservation, history, archaeology, architecture, planning, museum studies, and/or public history. Submissions related to New Jersey subject matter are especially encouraged (see more suggested topics at the end of this announcement).

Posters will be chosen from among the submissions for display at the conference. A prize of \$250 will be awarded for the best poster. All individuals whose posters are selected for display will receive complimentary registration to both the 2018 and 2019 conferences (a \$120 value).

Presenting a poster at the conference provides a unique opportunity to explore careers in history and historic preservation, network, and share your research and interest in history with a wider audience.

Evaluation Criteria

Posters will be chosen based on the persuasiveness of the abstract, clarity of the visual presentation, and the project's relation to major issues in the field.

Content Advice

A good poster should introduce the topic, research questions, methods, and/or best practices, and what was accomplished or learned. Tips for creating a poster:

- Include a title
- Use images to illustrate your points
- Label images with a title, photographer, and date
- Keep text brief
- All text should be printed, not handwritten
- Edit carefully
- The test of a good poster is if someone can read it in five minutes and understand your main points.
- Provide your contact information so attendees can reach you later with additional questions, resources, and/or suggestions

Topic Ideas

Please note: These are suggestions only; posters do not need to cover these areas to be considered for display at the conference.

- World War I in New Jersey (2018 concludes the 100th Anniversary)
- Monuments in New Jersey
- New Jersey's Maritime history
- Topics related to local history in Passaic County
- The history of historic preservation in New Jersey
- Connecting health of communities and neighborhoods with history and preservation
- Historic preservation's role in tourism
- Tools and initiatives that promote diversity in history and preservation
- Disability history

Formatting

- Poster should be no larger than 36" x 48" on poster board
- Poster should stand on its own on easel
- All posters will be displayed on an easel provided by the conference organizers

Submission Instructions

All proposals must include:

- Project Title
- Abstract that explains and promotes the project (limit 150 words)
- One-page CV or resume for each participant
- Simple visual mock-up of the display submitted as a PDF
- Contact information for each participant (Name, address, email, phone number, and affiliation)
