- Collected data from Wind, conducted panel data analysis and built two regression models in STATA
- Results: (1) the latest data of Asian countries supports the trend implied by the Kuznets hypothesis, and the • turning point is around 3,470 USD, a relatively low level; (2) the distribution of inequality level among different income levels is right averted, meaning that reducing inequality is not as easy as gaining it in the first stage of a country's economic development; (3) labor productivity difference between rural and urban areas is a mechanism that has significant influence on reducing inequality level
- Conclusion: enhancing the labor productivity of the rural sector is an effective way to reduce inequality •
