



The Macro-Financial Division of the Research Department of the [International Monetary Fund](#) conducts policy research on macroeconomic and financial issues critical to Fund surveillance activities. Current areas of focus include: digital money and fintech, inflation and monetary policy, macroprudential policies and climate finance among others.

The division is looking for a full-time research assistant (RA) that can start during the summer. The contract will be for one year with the possibility of extending it for a second year. The selected candidate should have an undergraduate in economics and prior research experience. S/he will demonstrate excellent data management skills (significant programming experience in standard econometric software (e.g., Stata, R, Python, etc.), familiarity with computer systems, and the ability to handle large databases) and a good understanding of basic macroeconomics and finance. The RA should already have or be able to quickly develop the ability to work with the various sources of financial information and data used in the IMF, such as Worldscope, Datastream, Orbis, Fitch Connect, and Bloomberg.
